Hello Mr. Friedmann,

In response to your data request dated March 17, 2008 the specific figures reported on TOMIS, the TDOC database, by staff at South Central Correctional Facility, the Hardeman County Correctional Facility, and the Whiteville Correctional Facility in Tennessee during the period of January 1, 2006 through and including October 12, 2006, are as follows:

1. Total number of inmate-on-inmate assaults, with and without weapons, whether or not injury resulted.
South Central = 33; Hardeman Co. = 9; Whiteville = 43
2. Total number of inmate-on-staff assaults, with and without weapons, whether or not injury resulted.
South Central = 18; Hardeman Co. = 12; Whiteville = 38
3. Total number of manufactured/homemade weapons discovered by staff.
South Central = 70; Hardeman Co. = 15; Whiteville = 50
4. Total number of use-of-force incidents reported.
South Central = 29; Hardeman Co. = 32; Whiteville = 74
5. Total number of incidents in which alcohol and/or drugs were found by staff.
South Central = 35; Hardeman Co. = 54; Whiteville = 71
6. Total number of disciplinary reports issued.
South Central = 2333; Hardeman Co. = 2074; Whiteville = 2550

Dear Mr. Friedmann:

This is in response to your April 2, 2008 request for records, as follows:

Specifically, I am requesting records maintained or received by the TDOC that relate to known instances where CCA employees have been charged with criminal offenses, whether or not in connection with their employment with CCA, including but not limited to the names of all such CCA employees, the type of criminal offense, date of offense, location of offense (e.g., facility) and disposition of charges if known, from January 1, 2003 to the date of this request.

I am requesting all such records whether they are available from TDOC central office or from the TDOC contract monitors/liaisons assigned to CCA-operated facilities. I am requesting all such records in electronic format to the extent that they are available in electronic form. A spreadsheet or listing of such instances with the requested data is sufficient if that is less burdensome than producing the underlying documents.

I am providing you with a copy of incident reports with an incident type of AFS (Arrest-Felony-Staff) or AMS (Arrest-Misdemeanor-Staff) from the CCA-operated facilities. I am also providing you with a report of employee arrests from those facilities from 2005 to 2008 generated by TDOC. If there are other specific documents you are seeking, please identify them more clearly.

The Department's charge for providing copies is twenty cents per page. The documents total 20 pages, for a total charge of \$4.00. Please forward a check in that amount, made


